About TCL

Trust Community Livelihoods (TCL) is working for social and economic development of Bahraich, Shrawasti, Barabanki, Maharajganj District of eastern Uttar Pradesh since last 11 years. TCL is specifically working on agriculture-based Livelihoods, primary education, migration, enterprise promotion, digital literacy and community institution building.

Roles and Responsibilities

1. Looking after the project activities, outputs and outcomes in the Gram Panchayats (GP)/villages allocated under the projects. The candidate must be very conversant with the objectives of the project and ensure the targets are met in territory allocated to her/him.
2. The project is about holistic development through agriculture & livestock based livelihoods and social development of women farmers.
3. You will lead overall interventions of the project in the allocated areas this includes agriculture, goat-based livestock interventions and social development in the project area.
4. Support Community Resource Persons (CRPs) to enhance knowledge on improved POPs of staple and star crops and introduction and expansion of High value Crops in the area.
5. Support CRPs to enhance knowledge on sustainable livestock rearing activities for quality implementation, assessing impact on target beneficiaries, and facilitating collaboration and convergence with government programs and other stakeholders in the selected geographies.
6. Support CRPs to form Producer Groups (PGs) at village level and Mahila Kisan Sangathan (MKS) at cluster level of women farmers and link them with Farmer Producer Company and regular monitor the health of these PGs and MKS.
7. Organized training of PG and MKS members time to time on technical and social aspects.
8. Developing and training a team of women CRPs and Pashu Sakhis in the GPs allocated. Prepare their work plans, monitor and support them in the field and carry out verification of data submitted by them.
9. Provide technical inputs to the community resource persons for improved livestock management and facilitate linkages with the district veterinary department along with building sustainable community institutions.
10. Identify community-based women animal health workers (PashuSakhis) and deliver a training curriculum to build their knowledge and capacity to deliver preventive health care services to livestock, emerging as entrepreneurs at the village level.

11. Organize village level camps to increase awareness on government entitlements and support women farmers to have access to government entitlements.
12. Mobilize/extend the required support to the block implementation team for timely and quality implementation of livestock activities.
13. Engage with livestock rearing communities and women's SHGs and help them in increasing their income through sustainable animal husbandry and manufacture of value-added products.
14. Look after all business activities that the women groups as Producer groups engage in from procurement to input supply and any kind of enterprise.
15. Build and maintain partnerships with relevant government departments, NGOs, women's SHGs, Gram Panchayats and other community organizations and stakeholders.
16. Work for convergence of the project with different government schemes and ensure that the farmers are registered and benefit from different schemes. Track and keep record of benefits.
17. Carry out layering and convergence with other projects of TCL to multiply the impact at the household level.
18. Maintain all field data, records and files and submit various reports as required.
19. Network with the Gram Pradhans in the Panchayats and the block officials, to ensure convergence of various project activities with MGNREGA, and other schemes of the government.
20. Any other task assigned by organization.

- Two years of work experience in similar field
- Should have computer knowledge and efficiency in MS Office and internet surfing
